



Shaolin Temple Cheshunt – Terms of Use

Every student and guest of the Shaolin Temple Cheshunt agrees to be bound by these conditions and by any other rules or instructions.

1. All students of the Shaolin Temple Cheshunt must ensure they register their presence with the Senior Coach prior to the beginning of each lesson and advise him they are leaving at the end of every class. Students are not permitted to leave the Shaolin Temple Cheshunt without permission of the Senior Coach.
2. We will endeavour to keep the Shaolin Temple Cheshunt operating during our opening hours as published, however, students and guests acknowledge that times may sometimes change.
3. At least 72 hours notice is required for the cancellation of any bookings made for private lessons, talks or presentations. Failure to do so will result in the booking fee forfeited. Refunds are available at the discretion of the Shaolin Temple Cheshunt. Tuition Fee for all classes must be paid by the last day of each term. Any payments received after the last day of term will encounter an additional £10 charge for admin and will be charged the new rate for the following term. We will begin to take payments for the following term during week 8 of each current term. TRIAL- Once a payment for a trial session has been paid and the Trial session has not been canceled at least 72 hours in advanced no refund will be available. MEMBERSHIP - Once payment for membership has been made there is a strict no refund policy in place. Membership includes a free uniform which will be received on payment for the term. TERM | HALF TERM - Term and half term payments are non refundable once the first session of the current term has commenced regardless if the student attends or not. Term payments allow the student to begin training from week 1. Half term payments allow a student to begin training from week 6. PAY AS YOU GO - Payments made for any classes are non refundable once the classes have begun.
4. Payments for all classes must be made on time. Failure to do so will result in a late payment fee being charged.
5. We reserve the right to alter the prices of classes. Where possible notification of any change will be provided in writing.
6. In the event of illness or injury, we can arrange for payments to be suspended provide we receive notice in writing together with a note from a doctor.
7. We reserve the right to refuse admission where necessary.
8. Guests attending events at the Shaolin Temple Cheshunt are required to control the behaviour of their children and supervise them at all times.
9. Any Adult attending an event with a child who is a student of the Shaolin Temple Cheshunt or who is not a student of the Shaolin Temple Cheshunt must supervise their child in all areas of the temple, especially in the Main Hall. Children are not permitted to touch candles, incense or weapons within the temple.
10. Any guest who fails to comply with these conditions, or in our opinion conducts themselves in an unbecoming manner or who's conduct could bring the Shaolin Temple Cheshunt into disrepute, may be asked to leave.
11. The Shaolin Temple Cheshunt accepts no liability for any illness or injury resulting from the use of the Shaolin Temple Cheshunt facilities due to over exertion or aggravation of a medical condition caused by such use.
12. recommend students seek medical advice before undertaking any exercise.
13. a changing area is available, students are advised not to leave money or valuables in the changing area. We do not accept responsibility for the loss or damage of such items.
14. is the policy of the Shaolin Temple Cheshunt to restrict the use of mobile phones to emergencies only.
15. smoking is permitted within any part of the Shaolin Temple Cheshunt or within view of the main gates.
16. Chewing gum must not be eaten within the Shaolin Temple.
